1. Standby Funds

- ₱21.63 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 109,977 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 92,409 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 15,768 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 42,758 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱733.35 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
