## I. Situation Overview

On 20 November 2023 at around 11:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Virginia, Culaba, Biliran. The fire was declared out at around 12:35 AM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

**One (1) family** or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Virginia, Culaba, Biliran** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Outside Evacuation Center
One (1) family or five (5) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Virginia, Culaba, Biliran** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P18,153.29** worth of assistance was provided by the DSWD to the affected family; of which, **P8,153.29** are **food and non-food items (FNIs)** and **P10,000.00** are financial assistance through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS)** (see Annex D).
