



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Virginia, Culaba, Biliran

as of 25 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 November 2023 at around 11:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Virginia, Culaba, Biliran. The fire was declared out at around 12:35 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Virginia, Culaba, Biliran** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Outside Evacuation Center
One (1) family or five (5) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Virginia, Culaba, Biliran** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P18,153.29** worth of assistance was provided by the DSWD to the affected family; of which, **P8,153.29** are **food and non-food items (FNIs)** and **P10,000.00** are financial assistance through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS)** (see Annex D).
