



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident In Tulunan, North Cotabato

as of 22 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 20 November 2023 at 4PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during thunderstorms in the rest of Mindanao.

On the same day at around 6PM, sustained heavy rains were experienced in low-lying barangays of Tulunan, North Cotabato that caused flashfloods in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,641 families** or **8,205 persons** are affected in **seven (7) barangays** in Tulunan, North Cotabato (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **70 families** or **350 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Popoyon Covered Court** in **Brgy. Poypoyon, Tulunan, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱869,730.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
