



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte

as of 09 November 2023, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 06 November 2023 at around 6AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Bugawas, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte between two (2) Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) groups that also affected families and persons residing in nearby areas.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 1,017 families or 5,085 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte (see Table 1).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **545 families** or **2,725 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Table 2).

## 1. Standby Funds

- ₱29.16 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

## 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 137,170 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 116,102 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 21,068 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 53,990 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱879.52 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.

#### b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

09 November 2023	DSWD FO XII in coordination with the LGU of Datu Odin Sinsuat in Maguindanao del Norte distributed FFPs to the affected families and persons.
08 November 2023	DSWD FO XII delivered the FFPs to the LGU of Datu Odin Sinsuat intended for distribution to the affected families and individuals.
07 November 2023	The LGU of Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte, through its Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) and in coordination with Alpha Company of the Philippine Army (PA), facilitated the distribution of food packs, jerry cans, and laminated sacks to the affected families and individuals.
