



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lam-an, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental

as of 13 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 October 2023 at around 10:00 AM, a fire incident transpired at Purok 2 and 5, Brgy. Lam-an, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 10:31 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **22 families** or **81 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lam-an, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **22 families** or **81 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** in **Brgy. Lam-an**, **Ozamis City**, **Misamis Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were totally damaged in **Brgy. Lam-an, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱727,028.30 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱177,028.30 from DSWD and ₱550,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
