

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pangobilian, Brooke's Point, Palawan

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 November 2023 at around 4:15 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pangobilian, Brooke's Point, Palawan. The fire was declared out at around 5:35 PM.
