I. Situation Overview

On 14 November 2023 at around 4:15 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pangobilian, Brooke's Point, Palawan. The fire was declared out at around 5:35 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) MIMAROPA

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **24 families** or **53 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pangobilian, Brooke's Point, Palawan** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- 168,670 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 106,702 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 61,968 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 82,374 FFPs available at DSWD FO MIMAROPA.
- ₱1.05 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO MIMAROPA warehouses.
