I. Situation Overview

On 27 October 2023 at around 1:50 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 7, Brgy. Port Poyohon, Butuan City. The fire was declared out at around 3:58 PM.

A total of **32 families** or **126 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Port Poyohon, Butuan City** (see Table 1).
