2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 142,370 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 95,802 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 46,568 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 92,685 FFPs available at DSWD FO MIMAROPA.
- ₱1.26 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO MIMAROPA warehouses.
