#### I. **Situation Overview**

On 06 November 2023 at around 1:35 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 2, Brgy. Tambacan, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 2:25 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) X
