I. Situation Overview

On 14 November 2023 at around 7:10 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Suliman, Brgy. Kap. Tomas Monteverde Sr., Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 12:50 PM.

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 170 families or 448 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. Tomas Monteverde, Davao City (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱10.45 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 168,670 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 106,702 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 61,968 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 38,402 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱1.06 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.
