





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Mw 6.8 Earthquake Incident in Sarangani, Davao Occidental

as of 19 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 November 2023 at 4:14 PM, a 6.8-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Sarangani, Davao Occidental (5.38°N, 125.24°E - 028 km S 68°W) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 063 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.




Figure 1. Areas affected by the Mw 6.8 Earthquake Incident in Sarangani, Davao Occidental

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **3,587 families** or **15,748 persons** are affected in **42 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of **759 houses** were damaged; of which, **96** are **totally damaged** and **663** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}10,943,573.00\$ worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}6,269,573.00\$ are food and non-food items (FNIs) and \$\mathbb{P}4,674,000.00\$ are financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) (see Annex C).

1. Status of Funds

- ₱10.45 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱10 million available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- ₱70.09 million available in DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the earthquake incident through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 168,670 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 106,702 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 61,968 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 101,954 FFPs available at DSWDs FOs XI and XII.
- 996,466 FFPs in DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the earthquake incident through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱1.91 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FOs warehouses.

19 November 2023	 DSWD FO XI augmented 1,000 FFPs to the LGU of Sarangani, Davao Occidental intended for distribution to the affected families, and as prepositioned relief goods ready and available to supplement the LGU's capability to respond to the needs of disaster-affected families and individuals given its geographic location and accessibility from mainland Davao. DSWD FO XI through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) provided 15 FFPs to the affected families and individuals in Don Marcelino, Davao Occidental.

DSWD FO XII facilitated the provision of 1,500 FFPs to the affected individuals, which include mall employees in General Santos City.

18 November 2023	 DSWD Disaster Response Management Group (DRMG) Undersecretary Diana Rose S. Cajipe, together with DRMB Director Michael Cristopher R. Mathay, attended the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) Response Cluster Meeting and convened the DRMG Cluster relative to the disaster response operations on the Mw 6.8 earthquake in Sarangani, Davao Occidental. The Disaster Response Management Bureau (DRMB) closely coordinated with the DSWD FOs for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation. DRMB prepared the Requisition Issuance Slip (RIS) for DSWD FO XII, which requested 50,000 FFPs for families affected by the earthquake. DRMB facilitated the approval of the activation of NDRRMC Response Cluster in connection with the Mw 6.8 earthquake in Sarangani, Davao Occidental. All DRMB Quick Response Team (QRT) members and emergency equipment were on standby and ready for deployment. NRLMB ensured replenishment and availability of FNIs for resource augmentation to DSWD FOs. NRLMB continuously conducted repacking of relief goods for possible augmentation.
