

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Flooding Incident in Midsayap, North Cotabato

as of 13 November 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 03 November 2023 at 4AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 5PM, low-lying barangays in the Municipality of Midsayap, North Cotabato experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,996 families** or **14,832 persons** are affected in **22 barangays** in **Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Table 1).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **134 families** or **541 persons** sought temporary shelter in **six (6) evacuation centers** in **Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Table 2).
