





# DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Mw 6.8 Earthquake Incident in Sarangani, Davao Occidental

as of 21 November 2023, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 17 November 2023 at 4:14 PM, a 6.8-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Sarangani, Davao Occidental (5.38°N, 125.24°E - 028 km S 68°W) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 063 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.



# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **7,517 families** or **34,939 persons** are affected in **98 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex A).

# III. Damaged Houses

A total of 3,250 houses were damaged; of which, 369 are totally damaged and 2,881 are partially damaged in Regions XI and XII (see Annex B).

## IV. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}17,744,474.78\$ worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}9,255,474.78\$ are food and non-food items (FNIs) and \$\mathbb{P}8,489,000.00\$ are financial assistance through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS)** (see Table 1).
