

DSWD DROMIC Report #8 on the Effects of a Low Pressure Area (LPA) and Shear Line as of 25 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 November 2023, a landslide incident occurred in Brgy. Pong-on, Bontoc in the Province of Southern Leyte due to the effects of LPA and Shear Line.

On 17 November 2023, the effects of LPA and Shear Line were also reported in the Municipalities of Magarao, Camarines Sur, and San Miguel, Catanduanes. On the same day, several barangays in Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental also experienced flooding due to the effects of Shear Line while the municipality of Pres. Carlos P. Garcia in Bohol and Catmon and Madrideojos in Cebu also reported the effects of the prevailing weather disturbances.


On 20 November 2023, several municipalities in the provinces of Aklan and Capiz experienced flooding due to the effects of Shear Line.

On 21 November 2023, the provinces of Camarines Norte, Masbate, and Sorsogon in the Bicol Region and the provinces of Biliran, Eastern Samar, Northern Samar, Western Samar, and Southern Leyte in Eastern Visayas have reported the effects of Shear Line. On the same day, additional affected areas were reported in Western Visayas.

Issued on 25 November 2023 at 4:00 PM, the Shear Line continuously affects the eastern section of Southern Luzon, the Northeast Monsoon continuously affects Northern and Central Luzon, and the Easterlies continuously affects Visayas and Mindanao.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **275,597 families** or **1,076,348 persons** are affected in **1,403 barangays** in **Regions V, VI, VII, VIII and X** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **17,631 families** or **73,796 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **157 evacuation centers** in **Regions VI and VIII** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **7,842 families** or **35,545 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives and/or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **25,473 families** or **109,341 persons** displaced in **Regions VI and VIII** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **308 houses** were damaged; of which **57 houses** are **totally damaged** and **251** are **partially damaged** in **Regions V, VI and VIII** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of **₱74,229,554.14** worth of **food and non-food items (FNIs)** was provided by DSWD to the affected families (see Table 1).
