

## DSWD DROMIC Report #9 on the Effects of Easterlies

as of 29 November 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On November 07, 2023, the effects of Easterlies were reported in various locations in the country. Several barangays in Regions X and XII encountered flash floods, widespread flooding and rain-induced landslide necessitating immediate response measures.

On 08 November 2023, the weather disturbance persisted affecting additional areas in Region XI leading to displacement of families and individuals.

Local authorities and disaster management teams are actively engaged in response and early recovery efforts to address the displacement concerns of the affected populations and managed the aftermath of the incidents caused by Easterlies.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **23,735 families** or **84,707 persons** are affected in **29 barangays** in **Regions X, XI, and XII** (see Table 1).
