

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bata, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

22 November 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On July 24, 2023, a fire erupted in Barangay Bata, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. According to the latest report from the Department of Social Services and Development (DSSD), the fire completely destroyed one house, resulting in the displacement of a family comprising two individuals. The affected family sought temporary shelter with their relatives.

The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the fire call, and the incident was declared officially extinguished around 2:40 PM. As per the conclusive report from the DSSD, the displaced family has successfully reconstructed their dwelling in the same barangay.
