## I. Situation Overview

On 26 October 2023, the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) experienced partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains that caused landslide in Brgy. Liwon, Asipulo, Ifugao.

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}19,210.95\$ worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}9,210.95\$ are food and non-food items (FNIs) and \$\mathbb{P}10,000.00\$ are financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) (see Annex D).
