

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of the Trough of Low Pressure Area

03 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

From 08 to 11 October 2023, the trough of a Low Pressure Area (LPA) generally affected Visayas and Mindanao.

On 09 October 2023, a flash flood incident occurred in the Municipality of Sibalom, Antique due to heavy rains. The next day, the effects of the trough of LPA were reported in the Municipalities of San Enrique and Barotac Viejo in Iloilo, and Cauayan in Negros Occidental. Flooding was also experienced in several barangays in the Municipality of Bansalan in Davao del Sur.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,608 families** or **10,345 persons** were affected in **32 barangays** in **Regions VI** and **XI** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **63 families** or **295 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **San Enrique, Iloilo** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **seven (7) families** or **30 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **70 families** or **325 persons** were displaced in **Regions VI** and **XI** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **23 houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** were **totally damaged** and **18** were **partially damaged** in **Regions VI** and **XI** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱378,398.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families, of which, **₱361,898.00** from the **DSWD**, comprising of **food and non-food items (FNIs)** amounting to **₱261,898.00** and **financial assistance** of **₱100,000.00** through the **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)**, and **₱16,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
