





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Balon Bato, Quezon City

20 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 May 2023, a fire transpired in the area beneath Camachile Bridge, situated in Brgy. Balon Bato, Quezon City. The fire start at around 4AM and was declared out at around 7:30 AM.
