

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cabug, Medina, Misamis Oriental

24 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On July 7, 2022, at approximately 3:35 AM, a residential fire incident occurred in Upper Mahayahay, Barangay Cabug, Medina, Misamis Oriental. The Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (MDRRMO) of Medina, in collaboration with the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), reported that the fire originated from the house of Edgar L. Dagoc and quickly spread to nearby houses, predominantly constructed with lightweight materials. The BFP declared that upon the arrival of the response team, the fire was extinguished after reaching the 1st level alarm.

Consequently, there were no recorded casualties resulting from the incident. Likewise, the affected families who chose to temporarily reside with their distant relatives have already returned to their homes.
