





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flash Flood Incidents in Camiguin

21 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

Issued on 26 September 2023 at 4AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by Southwest Monsson / localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day, the Municipalities of Mahinog and Sagay in Camiguin experienced flash floods due to heavy rainfall brought by the Southwest Monsoon.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **109 families** or **407 persons** were affected in **five (5) barangays** in the **Municipalities of Mahinog and Sagay, Camiguin** in **Camiguin** (see Annex A)

# III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **98 families** or **398 persons** sought temporary shelter in **five (5) evacuation centers** in **Camiguin** (see Annex B).

#### **b.** Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **11 families** or **49 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

# c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **109 families** or **407 persons** were displaced in **Camiguin** (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 17 houses were partially damaged in Camiguin (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱335,728.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱132,648.00 from DSWD and ₱203,080.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
