



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Cadiz City, Negros Occidental

25 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 23 October 2023 at 4AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to several parts of the country including Western Visayas.

On the same day at around 10AM, a flooding incident brought by isolated heavy rains occurred in barangays Caduha-an and Luna, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental. The flood subsided at around 4PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **26 families** or **102 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Cadiz City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱22,417.14** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱17,417.14** from **DSWD** and **₱5,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
