



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Malingao, Midsayap, North Cotabato

I. Situation Overview

On 07 December 2023 at around 7:00 PM, an encounter between the local armed groups in Brgy. Malingao, Midsayap, North Cotabato resulting to the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,228 families** or **6,140 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Malingao, Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **707 families** or **3,535 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **(3) three evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Malingao, Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **521 families** or **2,605 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives and/or friends in **Brgy. Malingao, Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 1,228 families or 6,140 persons displaced in Brgy. Malingao, Midsayap, North Cotabato (see Annex D).
