

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Mamasapano, Maguindanao del Sur

as of 21 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 December 2023, at around 1AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Tukanalipao, Mamasapano, Maguindanao del Sur between two (2) Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) factions that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

A total of **1,033 families** or **5,165 persons** are affected in **Mamasapano, Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex A).

There are **1,033 families** or **5,165 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).
