





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur

as of 04 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 01 December 2023, an armed conflict transpired at the border of Brgy. Ganta and Bakat in Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur between the 106<sup>th</sup> Base Command and 105<sup>th</sup> Base Command which are Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) affiliated groups.

A total of 1,179 families or 5,859 persons are affected in three (3) Barangays in Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur (see Annex A).
