

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Bombing Incident in Mindanao State University, Marawi City, Lanao del Sur

as of 08 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 December 2023, a bombing incident occurred at a gymnasium in Mindanao State University, Marawi City, Lanao del Sur resulting to four (4) reported deaths and several individuals injured. Affected students have been repatriated and returned to their respective provinces.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **110 persons** are affected by the **Bombing Incident** in **Marawi, City, Lanao del Sur**; of which **92** are from the province of **Zamboanga del Sur**, **17** are from **Zamboanga del Norte**, and **one (1) person** is from **Zamboanga Sibugay** in **Region IX** (See Table 1).
