



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Easterlies in Caraga Region

as of 27 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2023, the effects of Easterlies were reported in various locations in the Caraga Region. Certain areas of Agusan del Sur were placed under Orange Rainfall Warning Level while provinces of Agusan del Norte, Surigao del Norte, Surigao del Sur and Dinagat Islands experienced Yellow Warning Level. The Easterlies brought a significant amount of rain which led to the displacement of families living in low-lying areas.

Local authorities and disaster management teams are actively engaged in the response operation to address the displacement concerns of the affected populations and manage the incident caused by Easterlies.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **325 families** or **1,246 persons** are affected in **21 barangays** in **Caraga Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **64 families** or **249 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **5** evacuation centers in Agusan Del Norte, Agusan Del Sur, and Surigao Del Norte (see Annex B).

 Dutside Evacuation Center There are 19 families or 74 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **325 families** or **1,246 persons** displaced in **Caraga Region** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Butuan City, Agusan Del Norte, Caraga Region (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱32,157.00** worth of assistance from the Local Government Unit (LGU) was provided to the affected families (see Annex F).
