
DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Trough LPA in Brgy. Bobong, Kitaotao, Bukidnon

as of 12 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On October 8, 2023, at around 4:00 PM, Northern Mindanao experienced cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by the Trough of LPA. Possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains were expected. The rest of Mindanao was partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers and thunderstorms due to a Trough of LPA / Localized Thunderstorms. With this, strong winds associated with thunderstorms have been experienced by Bukidnon province specifically in Kitaotao affecting several families with damage to their houses and properties.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **21 families** or **105 persons** were affected in **Barangay Bobong** in **Kitaotao, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **5 families** or **25 persons** who temporarily stayed with their relatives and/or friends in **Brgy. Bobong, Kitaotao, Bukidnon**. Currently, these families have already made their way back to their damaged houses (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **21 houses** were damaged; of which, **5** are **totally damaged** and **16** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Bobong, Kitaotao, Bukidnon** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱30,000** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, is from the **Local Government Unit (LGU) of Kitaotao, Bukidnon** (see Annex D).
