## I. Situation Overview

On 23 December 2023 at around 6:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Bolinao, Brgy 1, Bacolod City.

## **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 19 families or 40 persons currently taking temporary shelter in A. Bonifacio Elementary School in Brgy. 1, Bacolod City (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of ten (10) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) are totally damaged and five (5) are partially damaged in Brgy. 1, Bacolod City (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P111,449.82** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
