

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 1, Bacolod City as of 25 December 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 December 2023 at around 6:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Bolinao, Brgy 1, Bacolod City.

A total of **19 families** or **40 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 1, Bacolod City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **19 families** or **40 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **A. Bonifacio Elementary School** in **Brgy. 1, Bacolod City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **ten (10) houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 1, Bacolod City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱111,449.82** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
