

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 105, Happyland Tondo, Manila City as of 12 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 December 2023 at around 3:05 AM, a fire incident transpired at Brgy. 105, Happyland Tondo, Manila City. Said fire was declared fire out at around 6:59 AM.

A total of **250 families** or **1,250 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 105, Happyland Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **250 families** or **307 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. 105, Happyland Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **84 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 105, Happyland Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
