





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City

as of 18 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 December 2023 at around 12:03 AM, a fire occurred at CP Garcia St., Cor. Moriones St., Brgy.123, Zone 9, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 2:18 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **21 families** or **84 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 123**, **Tondo**, **Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **21 families** or **84 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of nine (9) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P109,323.69** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
