

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental as of 28 December 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 December 2023 at around 12:10 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Paghidaet, Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 2:35 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **39 families** or **117 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **39 families** or **117 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Gymnasium** in **Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **16 houses** were damaged; of which, **13** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱244,369.71** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
