



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 3, Hinigiran, Negros Occidental

as of 15 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 December 2023 at around 6:54 AM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. 3, Hinigiran, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared fire out at around 7:55 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. 3, Hinigiran, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 3**, **Hinigiran**, **Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱3,108.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
