

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Asia, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental as of 28 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2023 at around 7:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Asia, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 8:15 PM.

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Asia, Hinoba-an** (see Annex C).
