I. Situation Overview

On 28 December 2023 at around 12:01 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bayan Luma IX, Imus, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 1:03 AM.

A total of **20 families** or **91 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Bayan Luma IX**, **Imus**, **Cavite** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 20 families or 91 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Covered Court of Treelane 3 in Brgy. Bayan Luma IX, Imus, Cavite (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 12 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Bayan Luma IX, Imus City, Cavite (see Annex C).
