I. Situation Overview

On 28 December 2023 at around 12:01 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bayan Luma IX, Imus, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 1:03 AM.

There are **20 families** or **91 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Covered Court** of **Treelane 3** in **Brgy. Bayan Luma IX, Imus, Cavite** (see Annex B).

A total of **12 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Bayan Luma IX, Imus City, Cavite** (see Annex C).
