I. Situation Overview

On 11 December 2023 at around 3:42 AM, a fire incident occurred at Unit 7, Upper Nawasa, Brgy. Commonwealth, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 5:47 AM.

A total of **80 families** or **307 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Commonwealth**, **Quezon City** (see Annex A).

A total of **80 families** or **307 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Purok 3 Covered Court** in **Brgy. Commonwealth, Quezon City** (see Annex B).

A total of **50 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Commonwealth**, **Quezon City** (see Annex C).
