



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Purok San Vicente, Brgy. Leon Garcia, Davao City

as of 27 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 December 2023 at around 1:14 AM, a fire incident transpired in Purok San Vicente, Brgy. Leon Garcia, Agdao, Davao City, resulting to displacement of families and individuals and damages to residential structures. The firefighting team gained control by 5:30 AM, and the fire was officially declared extinguished around 7:10 AM.

Local authorities and disaster management teams are actively involved in the response operation, to support the immediate needs of the affected population. The City Social Welfare and Development Office of Leon Garcia is currently evaluating the present situation of displaced families and individuals. Thus, the result of validation and assessment will be included in the upcoming reporting schedule.

A total of **357 families** or **1,428 persons** are affected in **Purok San Vicente, Brgy.** Leon Garcia, Davao City (see Annex A).
