





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lucab, Kabugao, Apayao

as of 15 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 December 2023 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lucab, Kabugao, Apayao. Resulting to displacement of one (1) family with corresponding three (3) persons. The reported residential house was declared totally damaged due to the incident.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or three (3) persons are affected in Brgy. Lucab, Kabugao, Apayao. (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or three (3) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Lucab, Kabugao, Apayao (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}65,000\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}10,000.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}55,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱95.036 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

- 45,095 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 36,903 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 8,192 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 37,103 FFPs available at DSWD FO CAR.
- ₱1.1 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CAR warehouses.
