I. Situation Overview

On 01 December 2023 at around 12:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion 1, Midsayap, North Cotabato.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **20 families** or **100 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion 1, Midsayap**, **North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **20 families** or **100 persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives and/or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **13 houses** were damaged; of which, **nine (9)** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion 1, Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱365,752.00 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families; of which, ₱165,752.00 are food and non-food items (FNIs) and ₱200,000.00 are financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) (see Annex D).
