I. Situation Overview

On 28 December 2023 at around 8:00AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. San Rafael, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 9:00AM.

One (1) house was **totally damaged** (see Annex C).
