I. Situation Overview

On 15 December 2023 at around 2:40 AM, a fire incident transpired at Brgy. Talaba II, Bacoor City, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 5:40 AM.

The CSWDO is now at the site conducting assessment for provision of assistance. Should there be additional assistance the FO will provide required assistance.
