I. Situation Overview

On 27 December 2023 at around 11:15 AM, a fire incident occurred at Calle Basa, Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City.

A total of **263 families** or **1,016 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **263 families** or **1,016 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Tugbungan Elementary School** in **Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **228 houses** were damaged; of which, **220** are **totally damaged** and **eight (8)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱669,030.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
