





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Apayao

as of 23 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 22 December 2023 at 4:00 PM, cloudy skies with rains caused by the Northeast Monsoon may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains.

On the same day, several Municipalities in the province of Apayao experienced flooding due to heavy rains caused by the Northeast Monsoon.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **510 families** or **1,806 persons** are affected in **19 barangays** in the province of **Apayao**, **Cordillera Administrative Region** (**CAR**) (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 124 families or 327 persons currently taking temporary shelter in 10 evacuation centers in the province of Apayao in CAR (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or three (3) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 125 families or 330 persons displaced in the province of Apayao (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in the municipality of Flora, Apayao (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}129,073.95\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}94,427.95\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}34,646.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).

DSWD FO CAR through its Social Welfare and Development SWAD in Apayao maintained close coordination with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) for significant disaster response updates and further relief augmentation requests.
