





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Malita, Davao Occidental

as of 30 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 29 November 2023 at 4AM, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms brought by the Easterlies may have caused flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Mainland Cagayan, Isabela, Aurora, Bulacan, Rizal, Laguna, Quezon, Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas, Caraga, and Davao Region.

On the same day, several barangays in the Municipality of Malita in Davao Occidental experienced flooding caused by the Easterlies.

A total of 165 families or 618 persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Malita, Davao Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 165 families or 618 persons currently taking temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Malita, Davao Occidental (see Annex B).
