



# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Shooting Incident in Brgy. Busaon, Banisilan, North Cotabato

as of 30 November 20223, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 01 November 2023, a shooting incident transpired in Brgy. Busaon, Banisilan, North Cotabato that led to the displacement of families and individuals. The incident stemmed from a *Rido* (family feud) between the clans of Yusoph Tico and Don Rajah Muda.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **936 families** or **2,690 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Busaon, Banisilan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **59** families or **269** persons temporarily staying with their relatives and/or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱826,018.40** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
