



# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Whirlwind Incident in Kabacan, North Cotabato

as of 10 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 09 December 2023 at around 3:40 PM, a whirlwind incident occurred in Kabacan, North Cotabato causing damages to several houses in the area.

# **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **34 families** or **170 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Kabacan**, **North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **six (6) families** or **30 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **29 houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **23** are **partially damaged** in **Kabacan**, **North Cotabato** (see Annex C).
